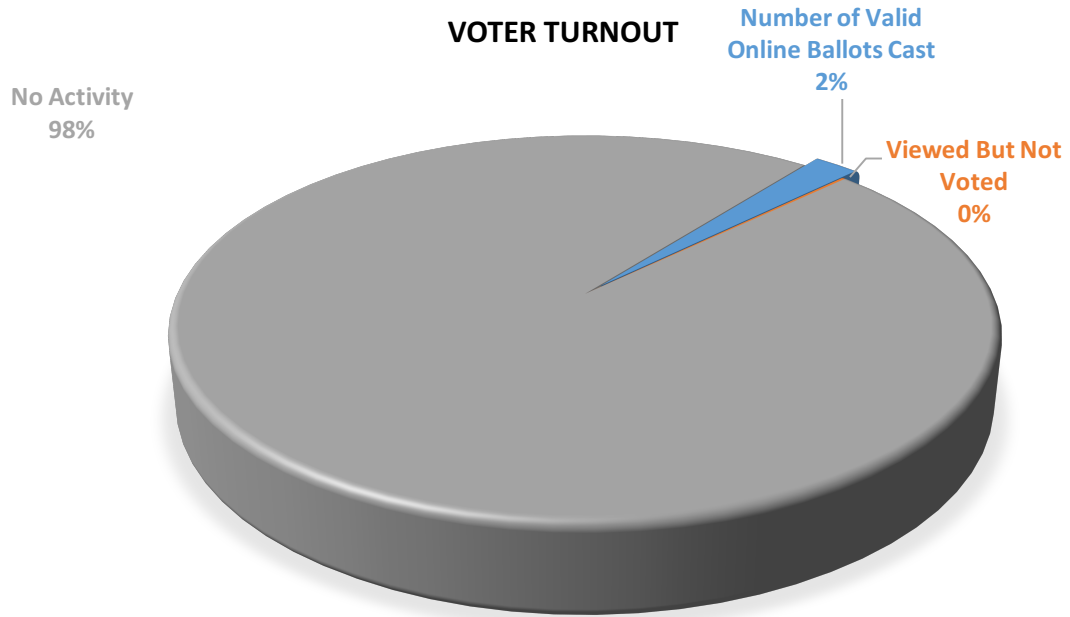

### Referendum for Partnering with LA Metro

The students are empowered to vote on imposing a student fee to support student transportation needs. LA Metro has agreed to pilot with at least one college to provide U-Passes to any credit student wanting to use the LA Metro rail and bus lines, and partnering agencies. See list below.

A vote in the affirmative to this referendum would:

- Allow the Board of Trustees to impose a mandatory student transportation fee on all credit students of \$13 per primary semester (Fall/Spring) and \$8 per intersession (Winter/Summer) for a period of three years.
- Allow the college to partner with LA Metro in a three year pilot to provide the Metro U-Pass at no additional cost to any credit student wishing to use public transportation.
- The fee will not be imposed on students until the college is approved for the pilot program by LA Metro.
- All credit students at the Pilot college would be eligible for a U-Pass.
- Fees would begin for the Winter 2020 intersession for the Pilot college only.
