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Associate Degree Requirements

Associate Degree Requirements: Title 5 Section 55063

1. Unit Requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 60 degree-applicable, semester units.
2. General Education Requirement: Students must complete one of the following general education plans:
 - Los Angeles Mission College General Education Plan (may NOT be used with the Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs))
 - CSUGE Breadth Certification Plan
 - IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum)
3. Major Requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 18 units in a major and each course required for the major must be passed with a “C” or higher to count toward the degree.
4. Scholarship Requirement: Students must complete all course work with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (“C”).
5. Competency Requirement: Students must demonstrate competency in Reading & Writing and Math by completion of the following with a grade of “C” or higher.
 - Reading & Writing Competency: English 101
 - Math Competency: Math 123C or 125 or a higher Math course with a grade of “C” or higher OR Math placement above Intermediate Algebra level.
6. Residency Requirement: Students must complete at least 12 units at Los Angeles Mission College

Petition for Graduation:

- Schedule an appointment with a counselor each semester to check progress towards your degree.
- If you have completed coursework at other colleges that you would like considered for credit on your LAMC degree, make an appointment with a counselor to complete the required petition.
- If applicable, have an official copy of all transcripts (including those from College Board for AP exams) from other institutions SENT directly to the Admissions Office (by the institution via US Mail ONLY) reflecting grades of all coursework completed.
- Schedule an appointment with your counselor during your final semester to verify that all degree requirements have been met and complete a Graduation Petition (deadlines for graduation petitions are posted each term).
- Submit your petition with all supporting documents to the Admissions Office.

NOTE: Completion of the General Education and Major Requirements for an Associate Degree may NOT make the student eligible to transfer to a four-year college or university. Consult the college catalog, your counselor and ASSIST (www.assist.org) regarding transfer requirements.
