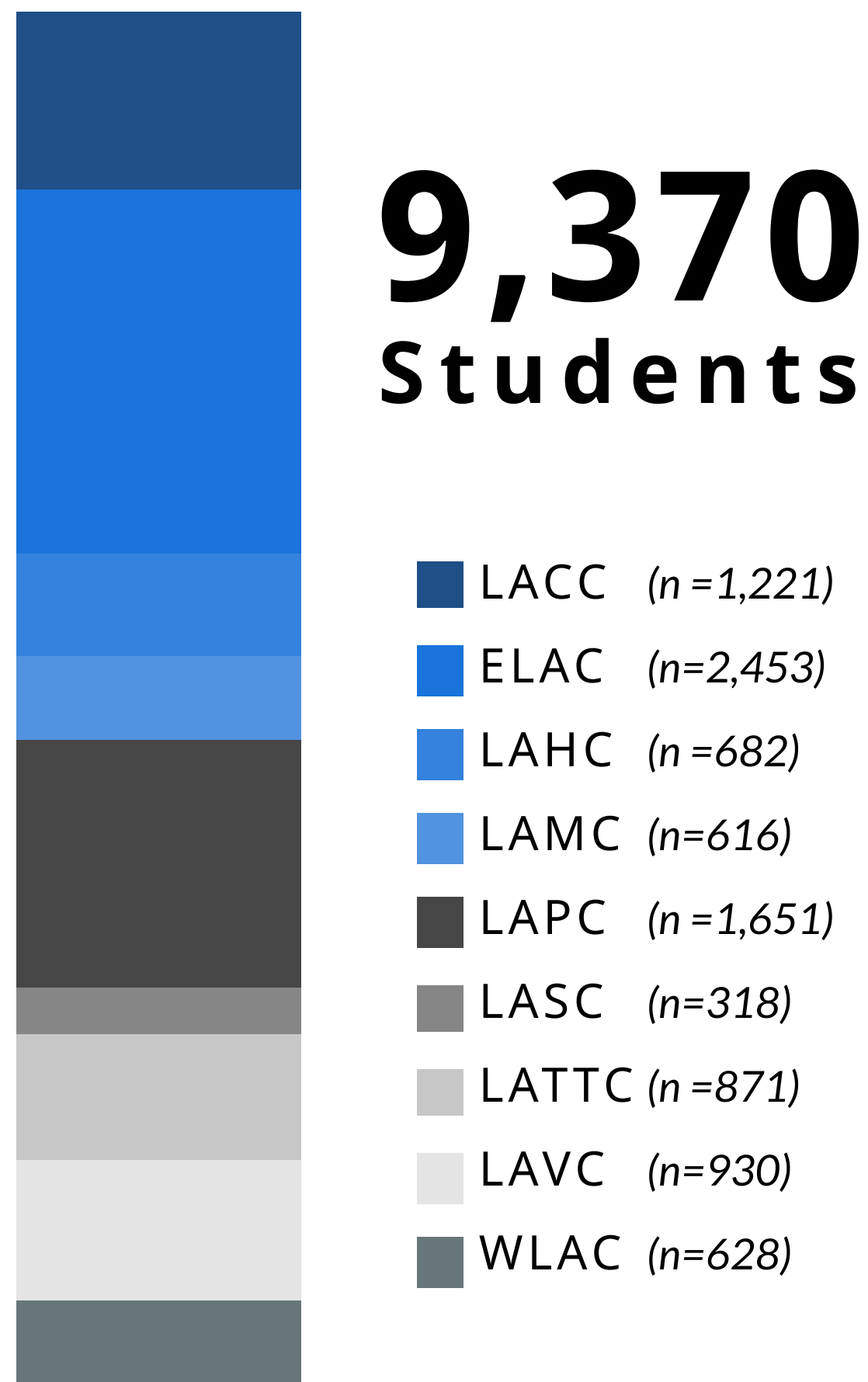

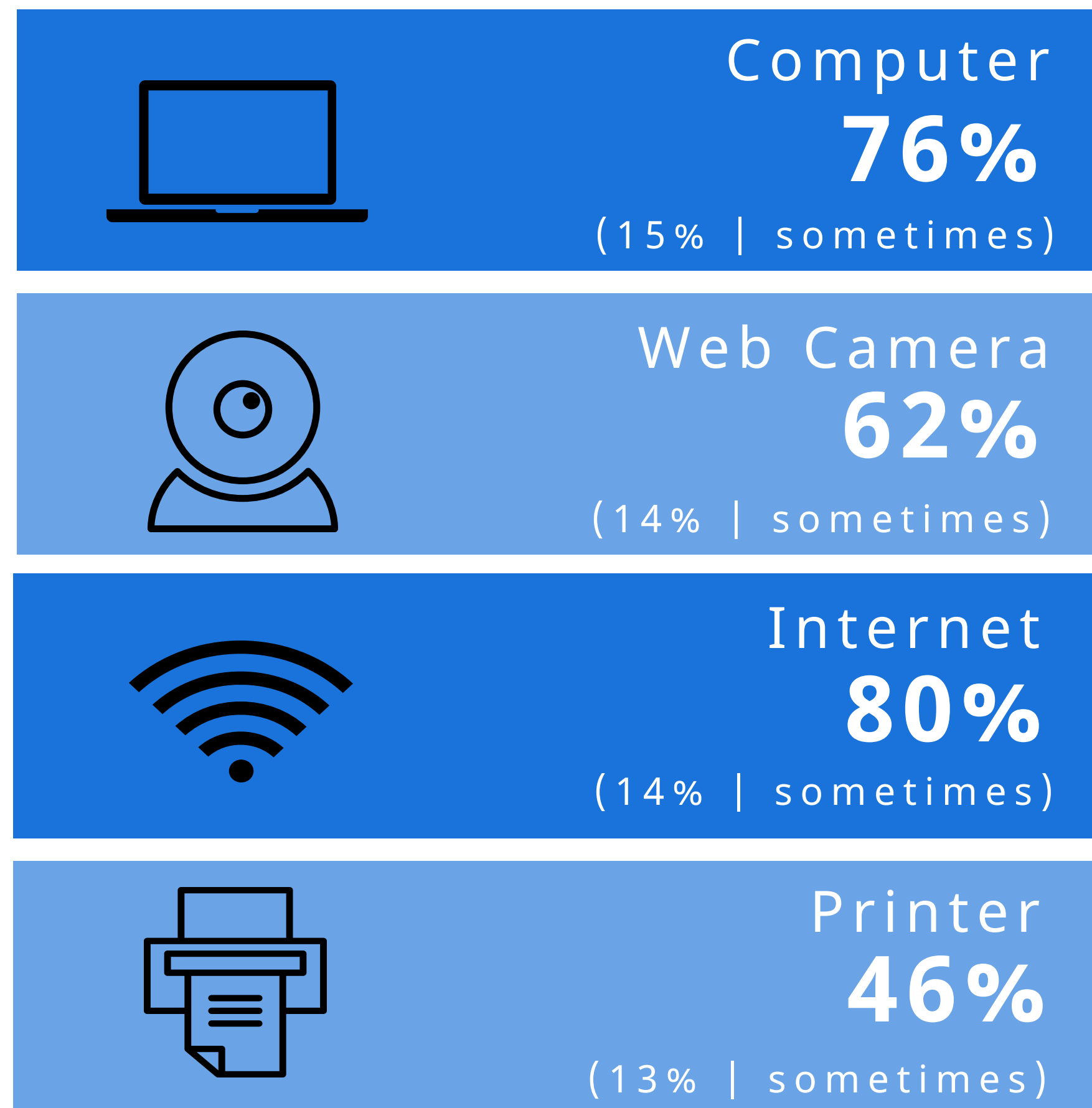

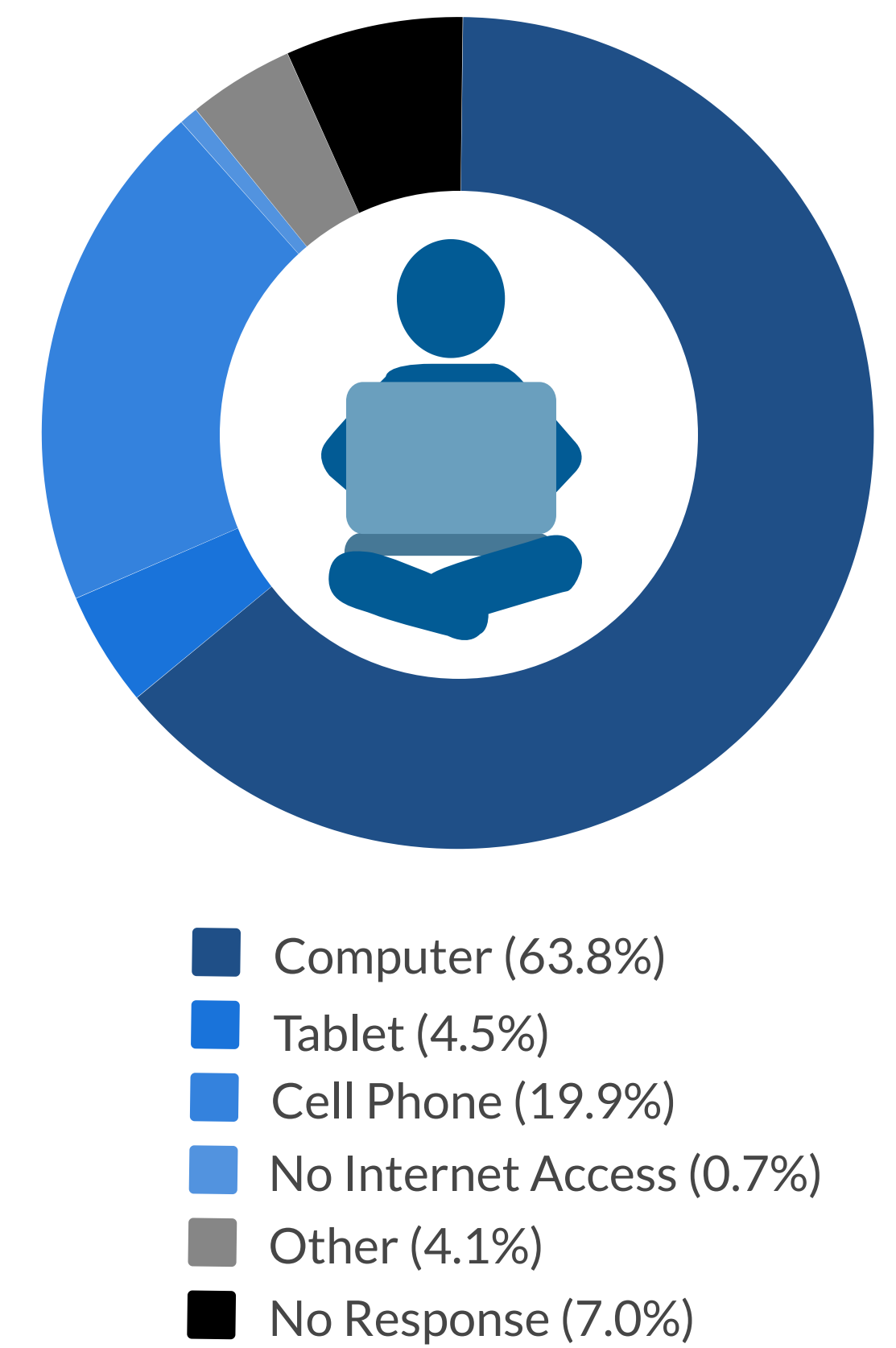
Number of Student Surveys Completed



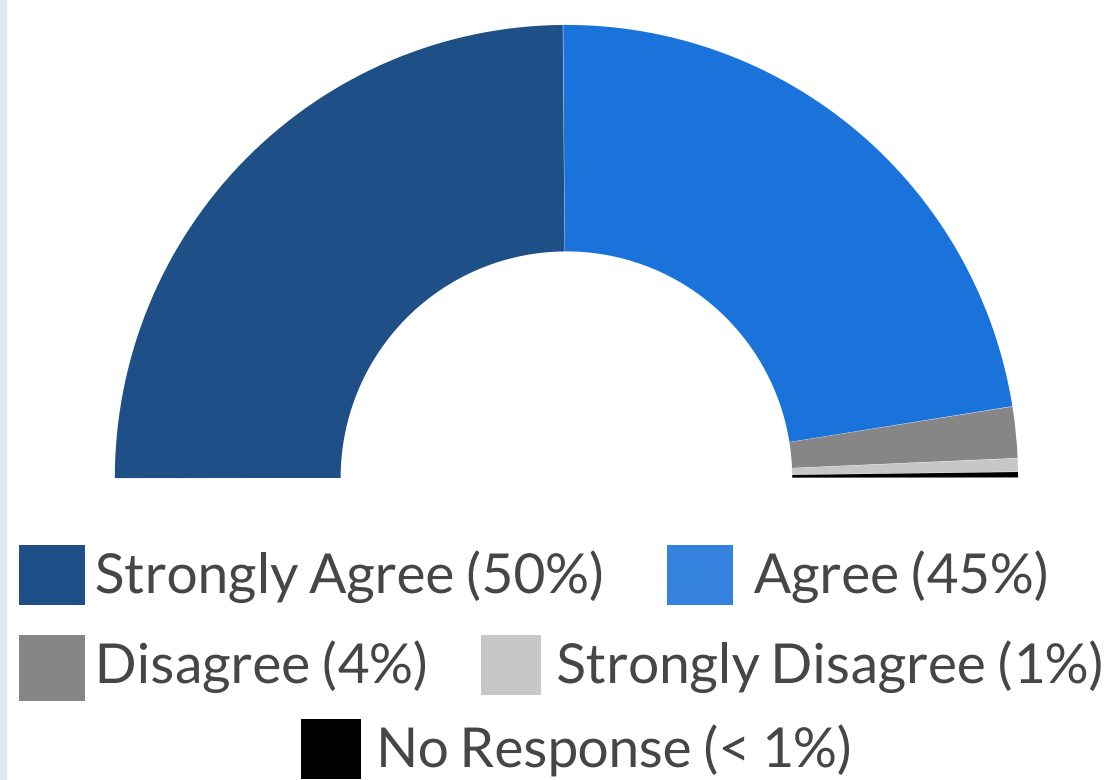
Students with Regular Access to Technology



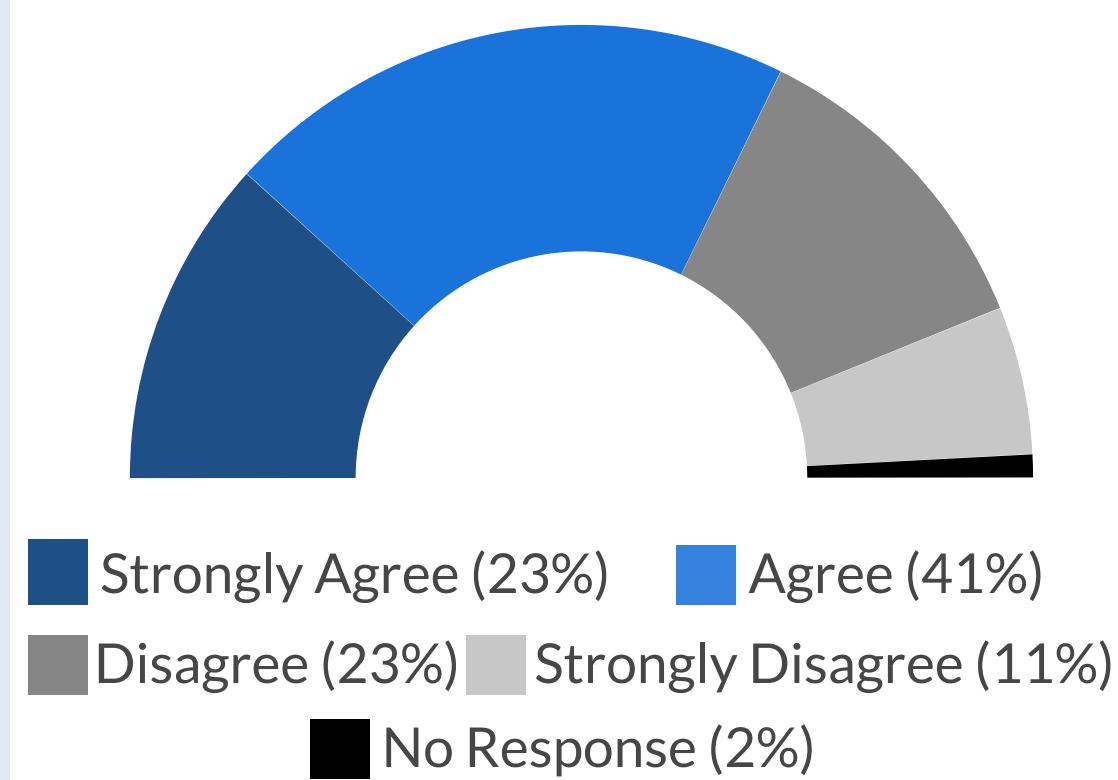
How Students Primarily Access their Classes



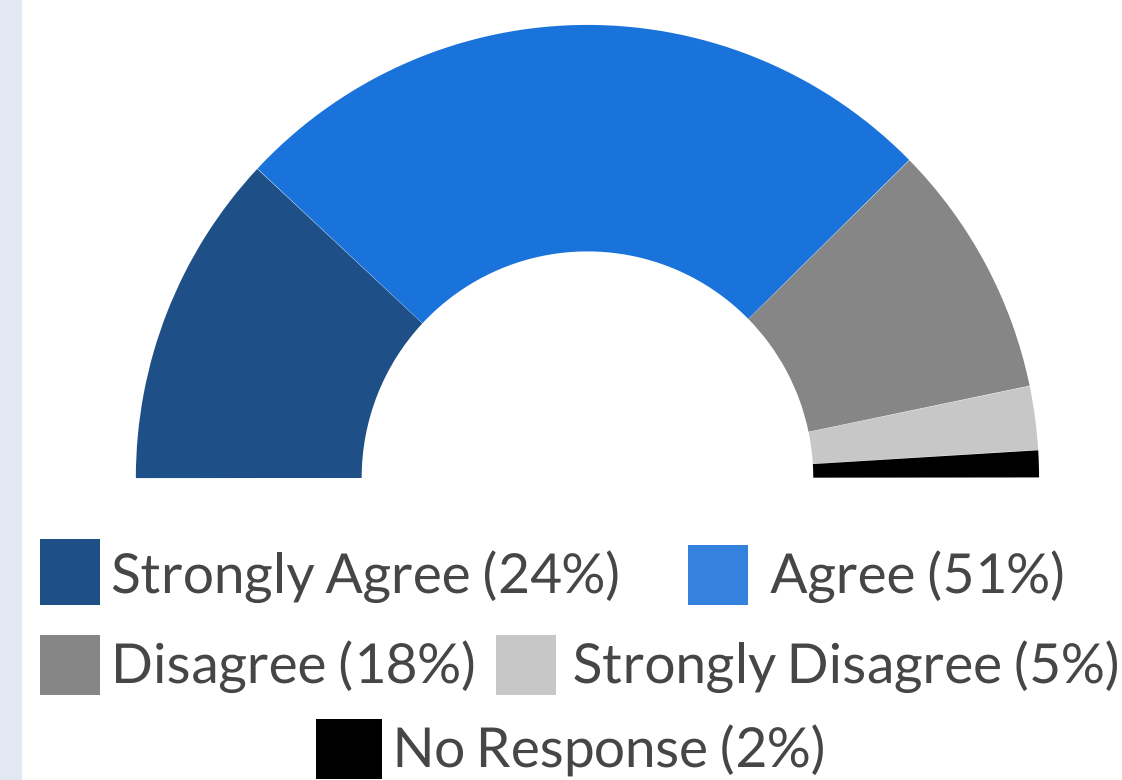
I am familiar with Canvas



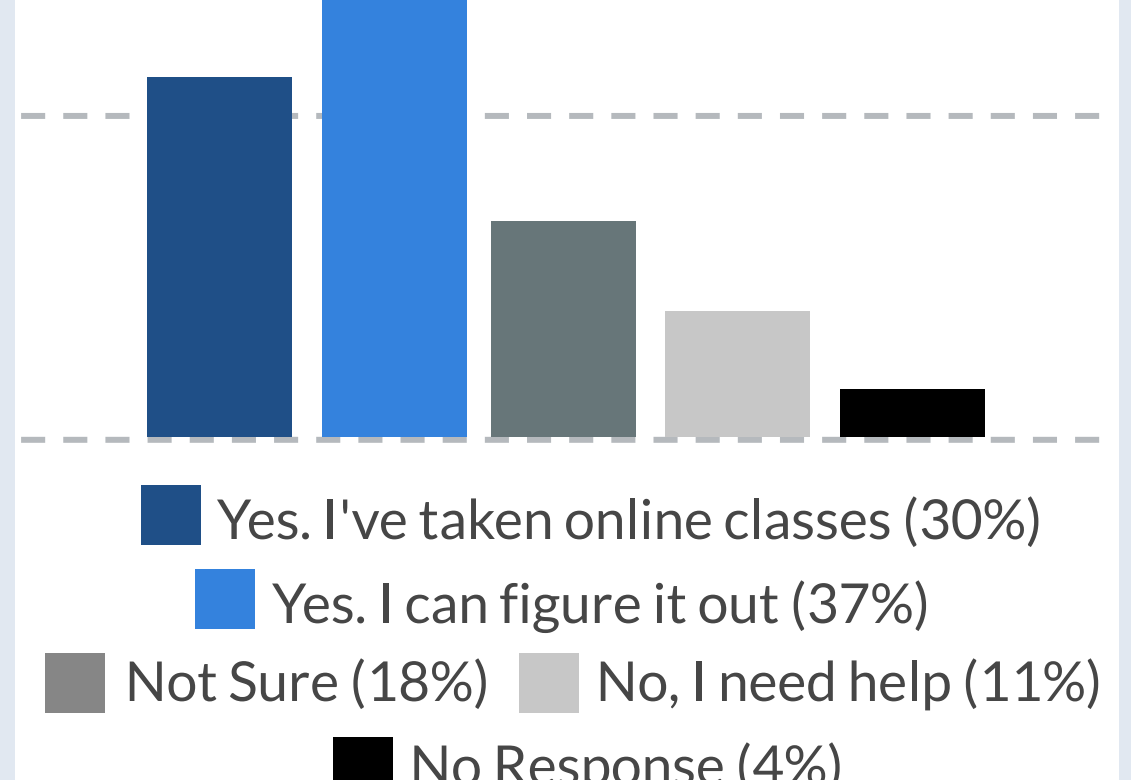
I have a quiet place to do my schoolwork



I have enough time to participate in classes

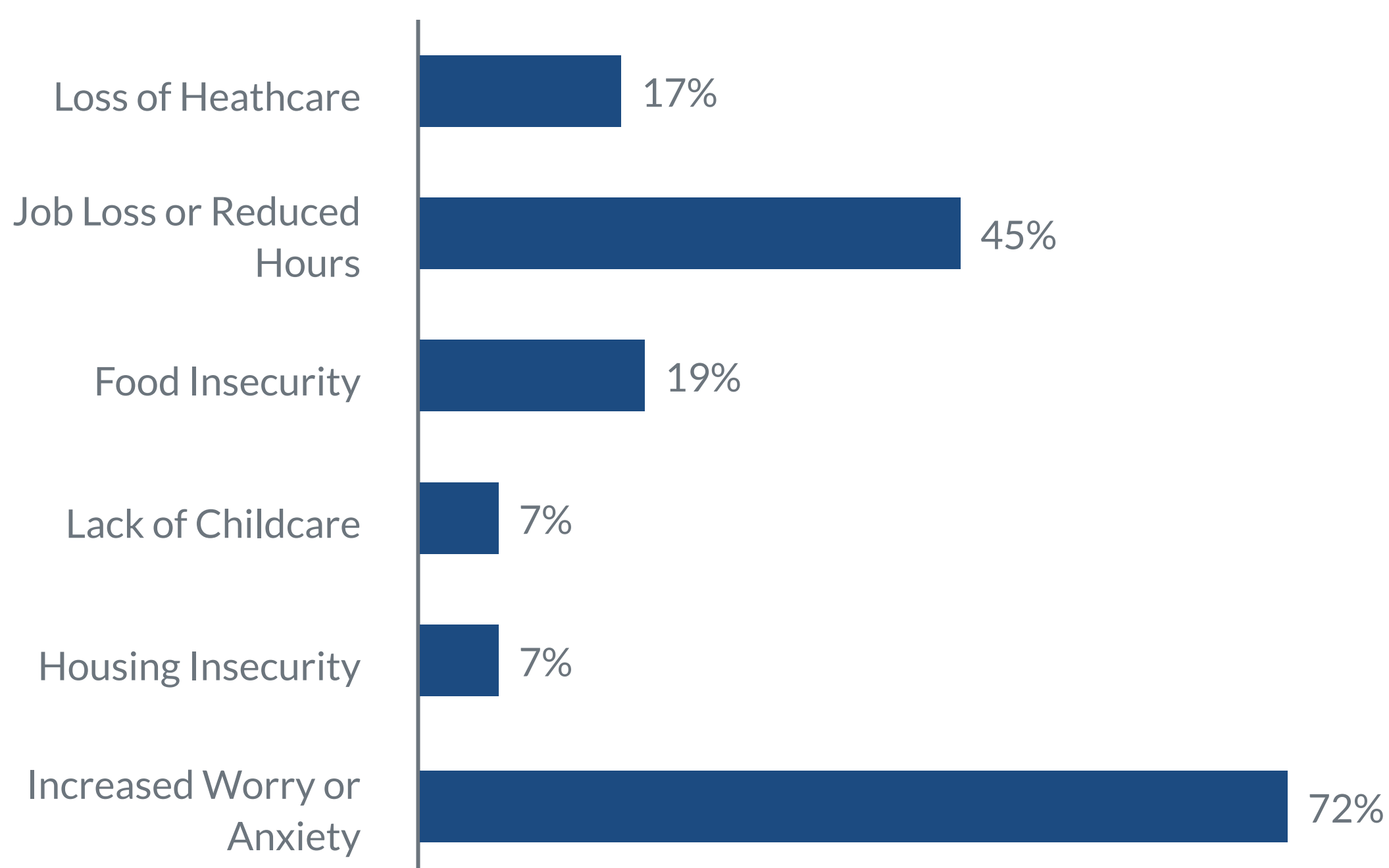


Do you feel prepared for online classes?



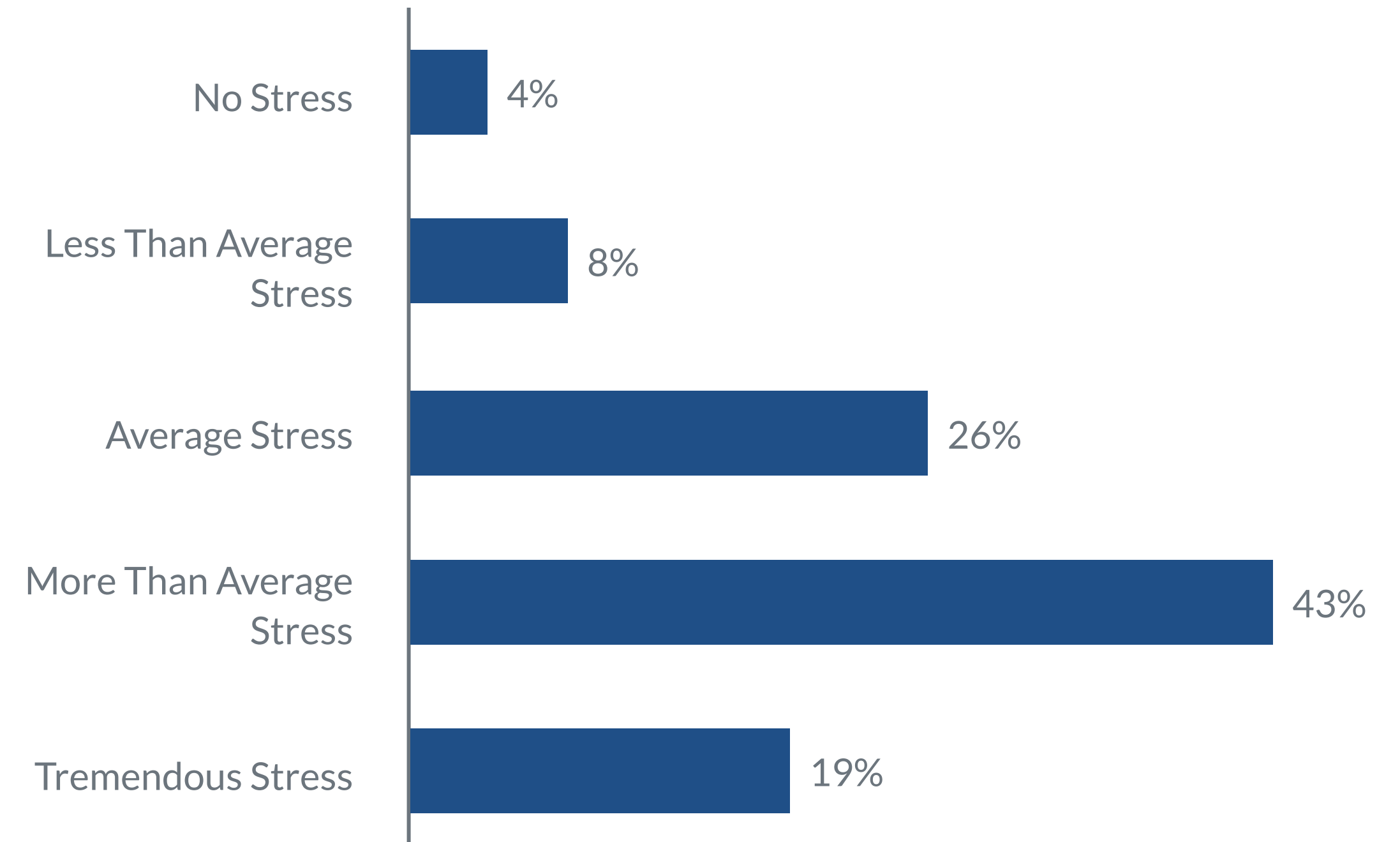
Personal Challenges

During this transition, what challenges have you been experiencing?



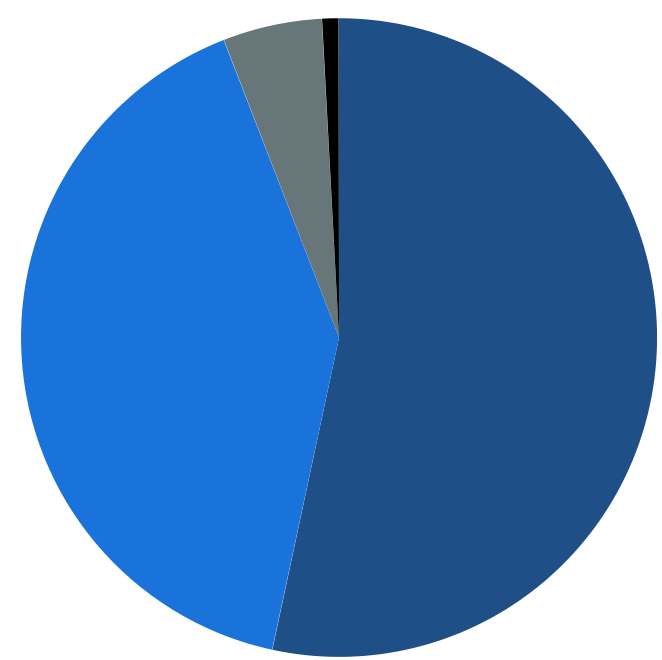
Current Stress Level

Within the last 30 days, how would you rate the your overall level of stress?



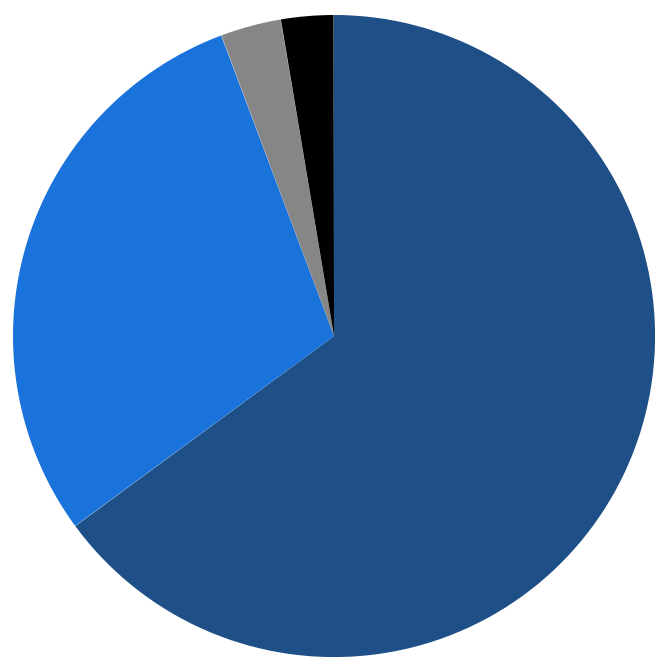

I have regular contact with my Instructor



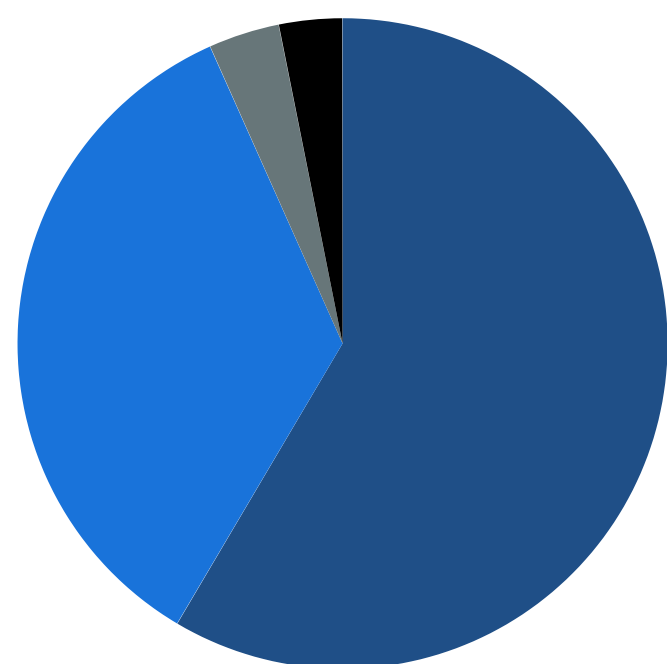
- In ALL my classes (53%)

- No Response (3%)

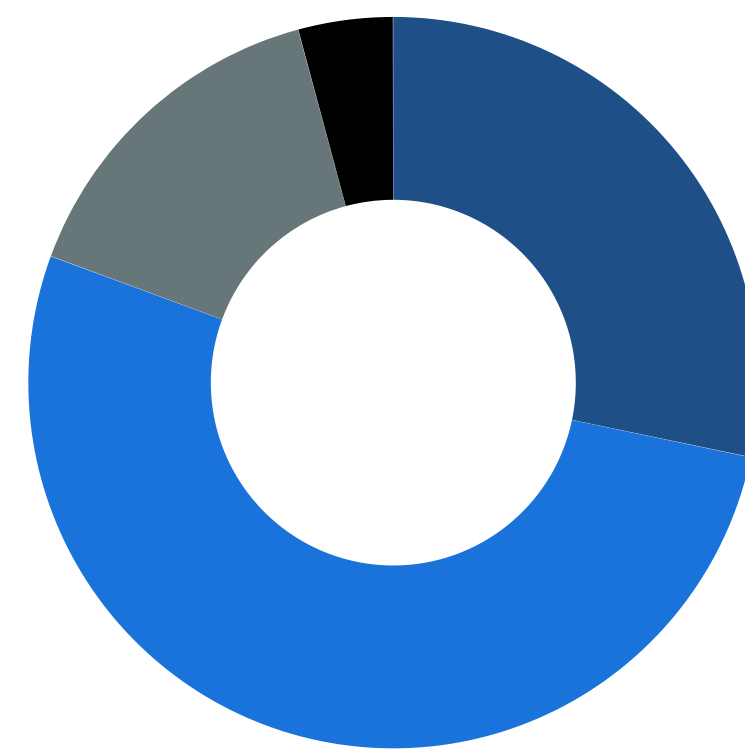
I know what work is expected of me in my classes

- No Response (3%)

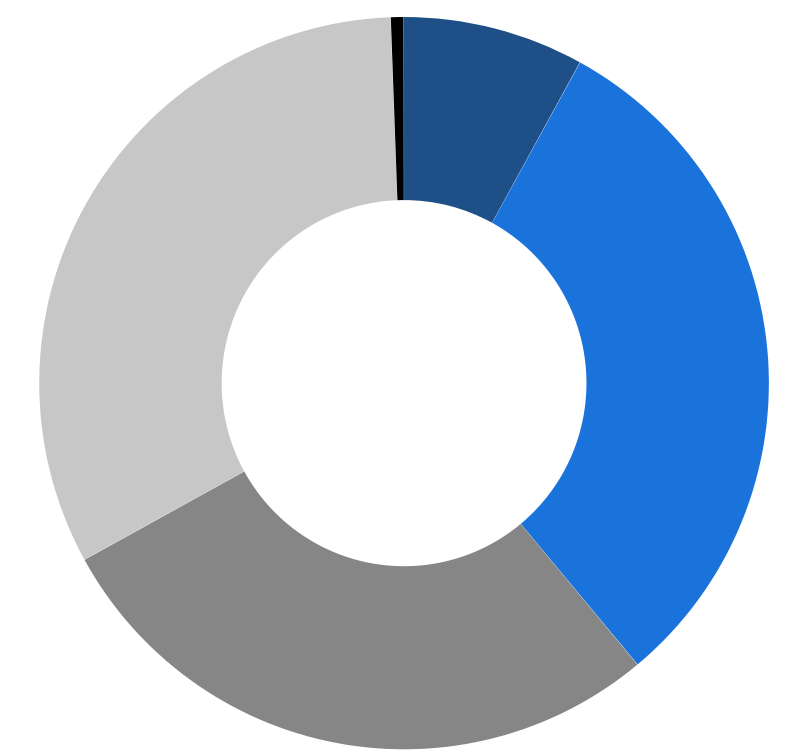
College Services

Are you aware college services are available remotely?



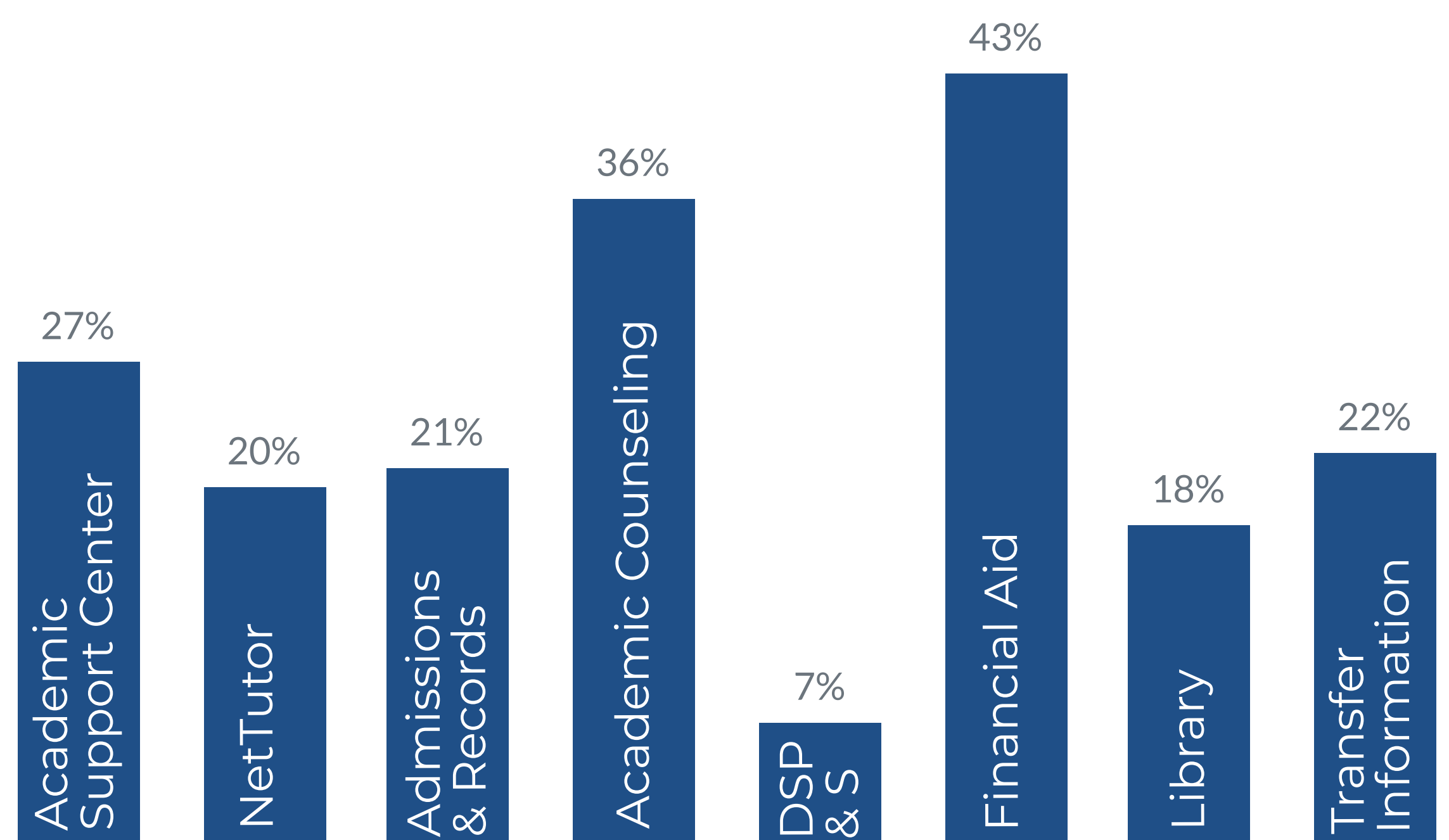
- Yes, I've tried accessing services (28%)

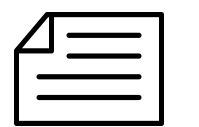
