The goal is to understand the study and creation of visual, print, and new media within the broader contexts of human visual and verbal expression and shape students into sophisticated readers and graphic culture producers. Multimedia studies include film studies, television studies, journalism, video production, computer animation, and studies and practices in multimedia, interactive media, and new technologies.

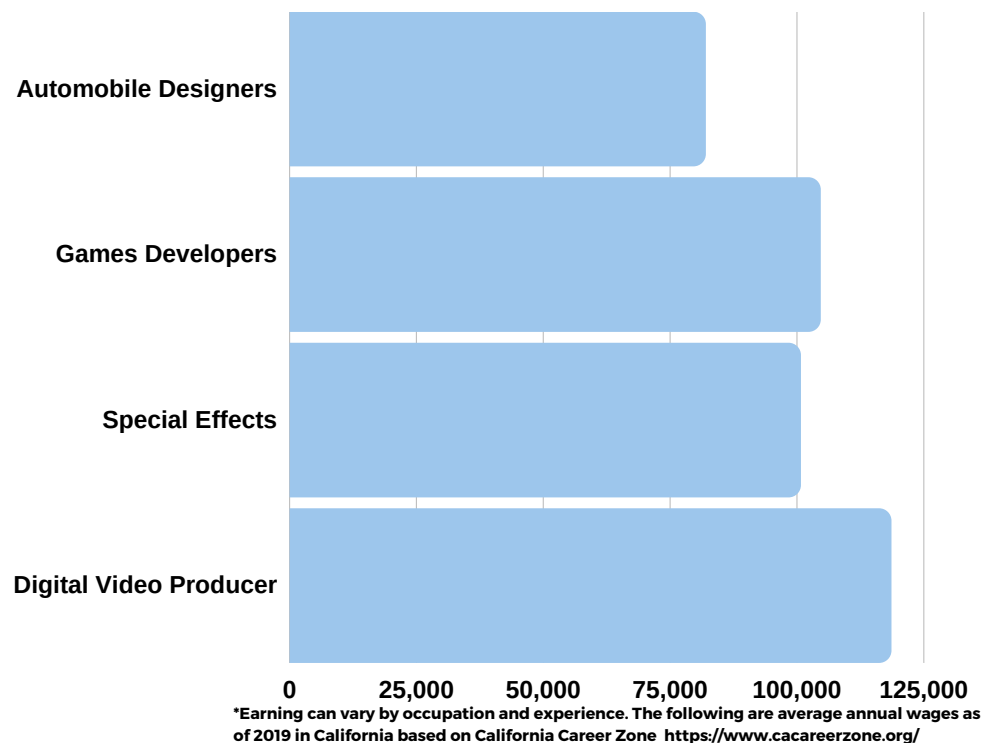
