Or go to lamission.edu > Schedule/Catalog (top right of the page) > Winter 2025 Schedule of Classes Online | WEB > search for subject or class number > select the desired class > scroll to "Important Class Dates" at the bottom part of the page. Deadlines for a "W" and refunds are included in this section.

A permission number is required starting the first day of class if the class is full/closed.

If the class is open and has seats available within the first 2 days of classes, a permission number is not required to enroll.

Permission numbers are issued by the instructor.

Students issued a permission number can enroll in classes using the Student Portal.

It is the student's responsibility to drop classes following the class deadlines. If you stop attending a class, or wish to drop a class, YOU MUST DROP THE CLASS YOURSELF through the student portal. Failure to do to may result in a grade of "F" in that class.
