ADDING/DROPPING CLASSES –

To Add/Drop classes, access the Student Portal > Manage Class Tile > select the desired class > Enrollment Information/Important Class Dates.

Or go to lamission.edu > Academics > Schedules & Catalogs > Spring 2025 Schedule of Classes |WEB > search for subject or class number > select the desired class > scroll to “Important Class Dates” at the bottom part of the page.

Deadlines for a “W” and refunds are included in this section.

A permission number is required starting the first day of class if the class is full/closed.

If the class is open and has seats available within the first 2 days of classes, a permission number is not required to enroll.

Permission numbers are issued by the instructor.

Students issued a permission number can enroll in classes using the Student Portal.

***NOTE:** Dates may vary by class. Please check these dates on your class schedule in the student portal.

It is the student’s responsibility to drop classes following the class deadlines.

If you stop attending a class, or wish to drop a class, YOU MUST DROP THE CLASS YOURSELF through the student portal.

Failure to do to may result in a grade of “F” in that class.

REMINDER: Course repetition is regulated by state guidelines, limiting students to a maximum of three (3) enrollments in a course, to include both substandard grades and withdrawals, unless otherwise specified in the course description.
